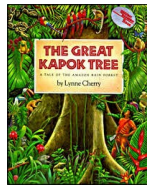

## English

In English, we will be looking at developing our non-fiction writing skills by creating non-chronological reports about animals linked

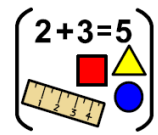


to the text *The Great Kapok Tree*. We will also link our English learning with our Computing learning as we explore different types of poetry and chose one to record ourselves reading aloud.

This half term we will be learning about different methods for multiplication and division, including compact column method multiplication and 'bus stop' division methods. We will also find out about finding factors and multiples.

## PE

For our indoor Real PE, we will be taking part in Real Dance. This will involve making shapes and considering how to put together a routine to a beat.

## Science

Our science this half term will focus on the solar system in which we live. We will be looking at the movement of the Earth relative to the Sun and

Moon as well as using the idea of Earth's rotation to explain day and night. We will also learn about the planets and their distances from each other.

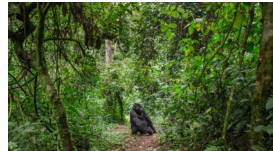


## Geography

to find out about trade that happens between products in the rainforest and our country. We will also consider the effects of deforestation.

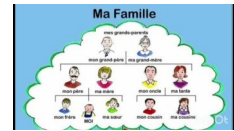
